Analysis

The stats of this match explain pretty clearly why Team Chaos won pretty easily. Their ratio of winners / unforced errors is much better than their opponent's. Julie Symons played the tightest match with only 2 unforced errors and 7 winners. As Julie and Jody don't have much offence they have to rely on making less mistakes than their opponents. They managed to keep a barely positive differential of +2. Geneviève and Lisa had 11 winners each but they also combined for 37 unforced errors for the worst differential at -15, this is way too high for what's expected at this level. At their defence they didn't have the chance to practice together before the tournament.
