Analysis

The stats of this match do not explain clearly why team Chaos won but that's because the second game was imbalanced and team Chaos made a lot of mistakes whereas in games 1 and 3 their differential (winners - direct errors) was better than Aki Québec's.

Overall all the players finished in the red but Geneviève Bousquet was close to be even as she hit 19 winners but had 20 direct errors. Maude had the worst differential and the 2 Chaos members had just a few clear winners. That's because they don't have much firepower in terms of spiking but they can keep the ball alive and still win if their opponents make too many bad plays.
